- 4. Must currently be a member of either W.H.O. or P.S.H.A.

We commend your initiative to undertake the scholarship process. Senior year is a busy time and we appreciate your accomplishments and efforts. Please return this sheet along with your application form. The following documented criteria for eligibility must be included:

- A completed application form (including parent signature)
- An official transcript from your high school
- A list of all extra-curricular activities, community service, volunteer hours, work experience and if and positions were held.
- Completed essay (300 word minimum)
- One letter of recommendation from a non-relative person (can be WHO/PSHA member)

All sections of the scholarship must be <u>received</u> (not postmarked) by August 20th, 2024. Judging will be based on scholastic ability, essay, participation in WHO/PSHA, and letter of recommendation.
